Please be sure to check your local donation site for specific guidelines regarding the size of accepted donations at that location.

- Clothing and linen
- Books
- CD's, records and cassettes
- DVD's, VHS, Blue Ray
- Video games, units and accessories
- Jewelry
- Electronics (no televisions)
- Computers and Computer Accessories
- Antiques and collectibles
- Shoes, belts and accessories
- Furniture
- Household décor
- Lamps
- Musical instruments
- Rugs
- Crafts and crafting supplies
- Housewares, kitchenware, glassware and small appliances
- Sporting goods, games, toys and bikes
- Exercise equipment and accessories
- Hand tools and small power tools

We're sorry, but we cannot accept these items:

- Televisions
- Broken or unsellable (stained) furniture
- Fire arms or ammunition
- Recalled items
- Paint, cleaning supplies, or other hazardous materials
- Mattresses, box springs, bed pillows, and water bed components
- Construction materials, plumbing or building supplies
- Automobile parts or tires
- Hot water heaters, water softeners, and furnaces
- Inoperable or damaged appliances
- Items with visible rodent or bug activity

Here are a few tips to ensure your donation delivers the maximum value to your community:

DO:

- When possible, separate clothing from household items in boxes or bags
- Wash clothing; keep shoes paired with a rubber band
- Wrap breakable items in newspaper and place in boxes
- Test electrical equipment and battery-operated items
- Include all pieces and parts to children's games & toys
- Clean computer hard drives of personal/business information and include the operating system

PLEASE DO NOT:

- Leave items unattended outside of the building
- Donate broken or heavily soiled items
- Give items that are recalled, banned or do not meet current safety standards.
